

## **Porta Potty Race Rules**

- 1. Porta Potty must resemble an outhouse or toilet in some way with a seat.
- 2. Teams must consist of at least one rider and at least one pusher, with a maximum of five people per team.
- 3. Racers under 13 years of age should enter the Pee Wee Race
- 4. No ice cleats or cleats of any kind
- 5. No motorized porta potties

Tips for Extra Points for the Creativity Prize:

- 1. Porta Potty could be equipped with wiping paraphernalia (corn cobs, junk mail, toilet paper, leaves, etc.)
- 2. Rider could wear a helmet
- 3. Name your porta potty!
- 4. Spend extra time decorating
- 5. Try using a theme
- 6. Have the team members dress up or match in some way
- 7. Consider incorporating music or sound effects

## Teams:

Teams will consist of no more than 5 members with one rider at all times. All team members must sign a waiver. If you swap out or add new team members at any point, they must also have a signed waiver at registration before racing. Failure to comply with the rules could result in disqualification. The winner of each heat will be determined by the front of the porta potty crossing the finish line. The judge's decisions are final. Trophies will be presented to the First, Second, and Third place race winners. There will be additional prizes awarded by the Judges to the Most Creative and Best Dressed Team.
